We have hoarded and squandered the gifts of creation.


We have failed to welcome the stranger and the outcast, and to make room at the table for the homeless and hungry.

#### Table Prayer


God of all creation,


#### The Eucharistic Prayer and Words of Institution



In the night in which he was betrayed ..


Together as the body of Christ, we proclaim the Lord's death until he comes again.

**The Lord's Prayer** 



For those worshiping at home, when invited by the pastor we encourage you to eat and drink trusting that this is God's free gift of grace for you.




